PASTORAL VACANCY ANNOUNCEMENT

Ministry Purpose:

The Pastor of the Church will be responsible to the church in proclaiming the gospel of Jesus Christ, to provide administrative leadership in all areas of church life and function, to teach the biblical revelations, to engage in pastoral care, to act as the chief administrator of church staff and conduct the ordinances and functions of worship in the church. The Pastor serves under the guidance of the Holy Spirit and the Holy Bible.

Primary Position Responsibilities:

- Plans and conducts worship services, developing sermons, leads in the observances of ordinances and coordinate with music ministry for worship services.
- Exemplify standards of personal behavior required in 1 Timothy 3:1-7 and 1 Peter 5:1-4, Titus 1:5-9, 1 Peter 5:1-4, Acts 20:28,32.
- Leads the congregation in effective programs to fulfill the Great Commission with vision, purpose, and priority.
- Maintains a regular program of bible study and prayer to plan and conduct meaningful worship services.
- Leads and demonstrates effective ways to witness and welcome individuals to salvation through Jesus Christ.
- Communicates (written and/or verbal) with the congregation through church announcements, church newsletters, church bulletins, church website and worship services.
- Conducts counseling sessions for premarital, family, bereavement, and illness etc., as needed.
- Performs wedding ceremonies, christenings, baptisms, Deacon Ordination and conduct funeral services.
- Trains deacons, church officers, and committees in performing assigned responsibilities and to carry out the mission and purpose of the church.
- Plans and promotes periods of evangelistic emphasis for the unsaved and renewal of Christian faith.
- Serves as chairman of the Church Leadership Team (Church Council) in planning, organizing, directing, coordinating, and evaluating the total church program.
- Serves to recommend and advise ministries and committees as an ex-officio member.
- Act as moderator for church business meetings per church Bylaws.
- Work with the staff and congregation to achieve the objectives of the church.
- Works with church ministries to develop a comprehensive church calendar.
- Directs visits and ministers to members and prospective members in homes, nursing care facilities, schools, and hospitals.
- Directs programs for new member orientation classes.

- Meets monthly with Trustees to review requisitions and purchase orders that relate to the church property and maintenance.
- Gives full support biblically to the budge of the church.
- Serves as resource and liaison person for committees related to the educational program.
- Promote /support special educational/training projects such as camps, retreats, and seminars.
- Plans special emphases in educational programs (i.e., attendance campaigns, leadership recognition, VBS promotion, Bible Study, Stewardship, and church Revival).
